Designation Allows Company's Security Solution To Be Used At U.S. Naval Bases In Continental United States

The ATO enables Defense ID, presently in use at several Naval bases, to potentially be purchased at Naval Bases across the Continental United States.

“We are pleased that the Navy recognizes the strict security methods employed in our system,” said Dr. Nelson Ludlow, CEO of Intellicheck Mobilisa. “The ATO certification process is a true testament to the Navy’s commitment to security.
